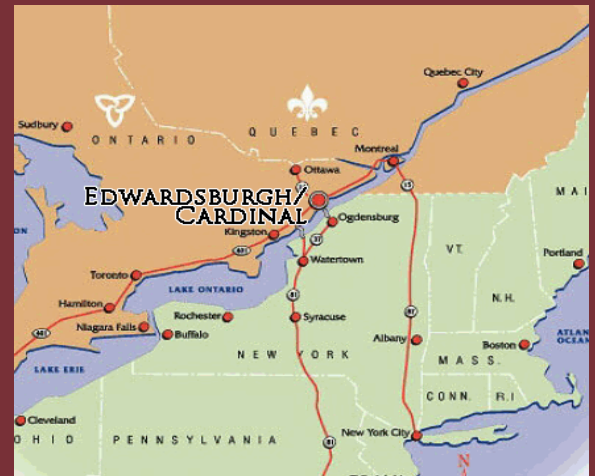


The Township of Edwardsburgh Cardinal is located along the majestic St. Lawrence River Seaway. The communities of Cardinal and Spencerville, as well as numerous rural hamlets, form the backbone of this friendly township. Historic sites, schools, recreational facilities, parks, and community businesses and organizations all provide welcoming opportunities for people to experience an excellent quality of life. Attractions include the Spencerville Mill and Battle of the Windmill National Historic Site.



Strategically located at the junction of Highway 401 and Highway 416, Edwardsburgh Cardinal has the Johnstown Industrial Park with acres of prime land available for industrial development. The Prescott-Ogdensburg International Bridge spans the St. Lawrence River at Johnstown and provides easy access to the United States. The township's deep sea port, the Port of Johnstown and grain elevators, connect it commercially to the North American Great Lakes and the world. The port underwent a \$35-million expansion project in 2016. The Canadian National Railway (CNR) line runs through the township. The Ontario East Wood Centre and Eco-industrial Park are being developed in an area that runs north from County Road 2 on about 50 acres of land near the port.
