Dr. Trevin Stratton is an award-winning business economist, specializing in global and technological change. Trevin is an advisor to both private and public sector leaders, and has counseled senior corporate executives and policymakers around the world.

Through his extensive experience building alliances among businesses, academic institutions, as well as trade associations, labour, and non-profit organizations, Trevin has been instrumental in shaping the public policy environment in Canada and abroad. Eastern Ontario's Connectivity Update

Lisa Severson | Director of Communications, Eastern Ontario Regional Network



Lisa Severson is the Director of Communications of the Eastern Ontario Regional Broadband Network (EORN). In Phase 1 of this Public-Private Partnership, over \$175 million of investment was made in Eastern Ontario to extend high-speed broadband access for rural residents. In Phase 2, which is currently underway, approximately \$213 million will be invested to fix the gaps and capacity in the cell networks in Eastern Ontario. Prior to EORN, Lisa spent 7 years with the United Counties of Leeds and Grenville.

Lisa works with all levels of government, indigenous communities, residents and businesses. Lisa has worked with the Eastern Ontario Warden's Caucus for 13 years and currently sits as a board member on the Eastern Ontario Leadership Council, is the Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM) representative on the TNCO working group, FCM's Technical Working Group.

Jim is one of the Co-Leads with the Eastern Ontario Regional Network. Jim has been a part of the Project since its earliest days.
